Warm Winter Hat to Knit

Make this cozy hat in an evening - it's just a tube gathered at the top!

Size: 22" (56cm) - add or subtract an even number of sts for larger or smaller hat.

Yarn: 2 strands of chunky or yarn combination to match gauge.

Stitch: K1, p1 rib - work into back of each st.

Knitting needle:

Circular size 17 (12.5mm).

Skill level:



YARDAGE 400 yards of chunky yarn (used double) or 200 yards of combination yarn.

GAUGE 2 sts and 3 rows = 1'' (2.5cm). With 2 strands of chunky or yarn combination, work 10 sts and 12 rows in rib pattern described above, measurement of 4 sts and 6 rows should be 2'' (5cm).

NOTE Gauge will change when brim is folded.

KNITTING INSTRUCTIONS

First row is worked straight across, followed by continuous rounds.

With 2 strands of chunky or yarn combination, CO 50 sts.

Row 1: K1, p1 across, working into back of each st.

Round 1: Making sure sts are not twisted, k1, p1 around, working into back of each st.

Repeat Round 1 until work measures 17" (43cm).

FINISHING

Cut yarn, leaving 12" (30cm) tail; with tapestry needle, thread yarn through all sts, gather tightly and secure on the inside of hat.

Weave all loose ends into back of work.

Fold brim twice.
